Shallow water rockfish fishing season has ended. Rockfish are now restricted to 50 fathoms (300 ft.) and greater. A few calico bass and sand bass are being taken as the warm water continues to hold.

COOKING YOUR CATCH

For a great appetizer or to top off a Poke bowl, a Hawaiian-style poke, serves 2 Poke bowls or an appetizer for 4.

- 8 oz sushi-grade tuna
- 3 chopped fresh green onions 2 Tbsp soy sauce
- 1 Tbsp sesame oil
- 1 Tbsp crushed roasted macadamia nuts 1/2 tsp grated fresh ginger
- 1/4 tsp kosher salt

For a garnish, 1 green onion thinly sliced, sesame seeds, and 1 fresh lemon to juice.

- Cut tuna into approximately 3/4-inch cubes.
- Place tuna, onions, soy sauce, sesame oil, macadamia nuts, ginger, and salt in a glass bowl. Toss lightly, then cover with saran wrap and refrigerate for 2 hours.
- To top a poke bowl put 1/4 cup cooked rice in bowl. Add a serving of poke, then garnish with green onion, sesame seed and drizzle fresh lemon over top.
- Otherwise as an appetizer, top with sliced onion, sesame seed and drizzle lemon juice over top. Serve with crackers or as is.
