NEW / UPDATED CHARTER PAYMENT POLICY

The club leaders agreed on a payment policy that would streamline the process and not overly burden the charter master with last minute cancellations to fill – or expect the remaining fishers to share the balance due. Here it is:

- 45 days prior to the trip, we will start taking payment.
- 30 days prior to trip, full payment due.
- At 30 before the trip, if you are unable to go, we expect your help filling the spot. We will try to fill the spot from the landing.
- Refunds only if your spot is filled

CURRENT FISHING CONDITIONS / FISHING REPORTS

The annual rockfish closure is now in place locally through March 31. There is only a six-month shallow water rockfish season.

The rockfish rules are complicated by a new 50 fathom line, which is a line connecting a set of GPS waypoints. The rules now define inshore versus offshore of this line.

- April 1st to June 30th, all depths.
- July1st to September 30th, inshore of 50 fathom line only.
- After October 1st, offshore of 50 fathom line only.

Expect a few weekend trips to be available for a mix of sand dabs and white fish. The Federal fisheries management council will meet in April to establish rules for any potential salmon season.

Long range boats have been getting consistent quality yellowfin tuna at the ridge since mid-August and no sign of drop off yet. San Diego boats will begin runs to Colnet reef for rockfish and occasional yellowtail.

COOKING YOUR CATCH

Macadamia crusted yellowtail Submitted by Norm Rodewald

1 lb yellowtail fillets

1/2 cup macadamia nuts

1/3 cup panko breadcrumbs

1/4 cube butter

1 Tbsp olive oil salt and pepper to taste



Preheat oven to 350.

Pat dry fillets. Chop macadamia nuts in food processor to rough chop. Mix nuts and panko in a pan and brown for 3-4 minutes in oven, place in large plate. Place butter in saucepan and heat over medium heat until lightly brown, transfer to shallow bowl.

Dip fillets in butter then dredge in nut mix, pressing mix into fillets to bond. Heat olive oil over medium heat in an oven proof skillet. Place fillets in skillet, cook for 4-5 minutes, nuts should be brown but not burned. Turn fillets in the pan, then finish in oven for 5-6 minutes.
