Brian Nguyen's WSB Ceviche Recipe! < <u>LINK</u>

What better way to appreciate an incredible White Seabass season than to enjoy it with family....it is indeed one of my favorites for ceviche! **The Cigar A'fishin'ado's Favorite Way:**

1.5lbs of White Seabass, diced
Juice of 8 limes
1/2 a small onion, finely chopped
2 seeded Roma tomatoes, diced
1/3 Jalapeño pepper, minced
2 Tablespoons minced cilantro
2 Tablespoons minced green olives
2 Teaspoons sea salt
1/2 Teaspoon black pepper
1/2 Teaspoon of sugar
1 Tablespoon Extra Virgin Olive Oil

Soak White Seabass and onion in the fridge (covered) with enough lime juice that they float in your bowl. After 2-3 hours, carefully drain all liquid.

Mix in remaining ingredients, serve on tostada shells or tortilla chips, add a cold beer, and ENJOY!
