



THE TANGLER VS THE ANGLER

LLLLLET'S GET READY TO RRRRUMBLLLLLLLLLLLLEEEEEEEEE!

If you've ever fished rockfish on a drift......
--How are there those who seem to avoid tangles and those who keep getting into them?

I started sportboat fishing in the late...when it was all chovy. I'm gonna admit: I was the kid you wanted to stay away from! Every mistake, I made. Casting over people, stepping left when I should have gone right, going over when I should have gone under. It wasn't pretty and I was tangling everyone up who was within "social distance"!

Thinking back, I can't recall any type of rigging or piece of tackle that would minimize or prevent my tangles from happening. What helped? Asking the right questions. How did I arrive at the right questions? It wasn't from praying for others to just stay away from me at the rail. I swore it was them, not me! Or so I thought. But I realized what (or in this case) who the common denominator was in each tangle I got involved in: ME!!

When self-realization kicked in, so did my education. I wanted to be self-sufficient on a sportboat. If someone "in the know" (captain, crewman, cook, or passenger) wasn't outright with teaching, I was asking them questions. And vice versa, if they were outright with sharing their knowledge, I was listening. I looked into everything to learn how to not be a liability to myself or others.

I can comfortably fish with anyone. Newbie, expert, legend, whomever, and whatever. I don't impede on anyone's progress, and certainly not my own. I worked hard for this. In fact, I'm still working at it, and I still ask tons of questions. But no matter what level I ever felt I was at, I always wanted to do better. And because of this, I indeed got better. Fishing is a sport, a proactive one. The ones who get it DO WORK before their trip, during their trip, and after their trip.

FEATURED SPEAKER for AUGUST: FRANK SULLIVAN

The topic for the August 6th meeting, will be a short history of the White Seabass Growout program at Channel Island Harbor – and an update about this year's growout.

Frank's Bio:

Frank Sullivan retired from Colton Police department as a Detective Lieutenant after 29 years in law enforcement in 2000. He then moved to Channel Islands Harbor to pursue his dream retirement, fishing for Billfish and other species out of the Channel Islands Harbor.

He purchased a 1979 Viking 35 Convertible Sportfisher and began his journey. Fished the Channel Islands Billfish Tournament every year from 2004 to 2019 when sold Valkyrie because of medical reasons.

He joined the Channel Islands Yacht Club in 2003 and found that they had built and staffed the White Seabass Grow out Facility in the Channel Islands Harbor. He began as one of the volunteers and in about 2010 became the Growout pen Coordinator and continues today.
