
We are hoping to extend the invitation to female friends (non-club members) and/or wives, of club members to join in on the fun!



We fished up the coast off Carpentaria shallow for limit style calico bass fishing with a smattering of sand bass, bonito, whitefish; apparently no one told the fish it's December!

After finishing off the calico limits we headed offshore towards the hump for some cod fishing, got sportier the further off the coast we went, picked off a few but was unfishable by early afternoon. FACT: IT HURTS TO LOSE A FISH . . .

and it really stings to lose one in the end game. It may not be the cause of every lost fish, but a surprising number of heartbreaks can be traced back to one culprit: UNCONTROLLED SLACK LINE.

UNCONTROLLED SLACK LINE from other anglers crossing over your line while you're tight to a fish...

UNCONTROLLED SLACK LINE from not turning the handle fast enough when the fish charges the boat...

UNCONTROLLED SLACK LINE from not walking and winding —turning the handle while following your fish up and down the rail...

UNCONTROLLED SLACK LINE from relying too heavily on the low gear of your two-speed reel...

UNCONTROLLED SLACK LINE when you lift the rod too high against a circling fish...

UNCONTROLLED SLACK LINE from chasing your line while your fish is in its death spiral, letting it widen its circle...

UNCONTROLLED SLACK LINE from seesawing between tight, slack, tight, slack throughout the fight—often ending in a pulled hook...

UNCONTROLLED SLACK LINE from not following your fish...

Staying in front of your fish buys you more time to get out of trouble. Staying tight—more connected—to your fish boosts your hook-to-land ratio. And interestingly enough, your heart goes slack when you lose a fish...

"Keep your spirit light, YOUR LINES TIGHT, and your goals in sight."










cook your catch



January's Recipe: Baked White Seabass with Lemon Herb Sauce Fish

Fast, fresh, and tasty, just like you!

Ingredients:

- 1 lb white sea bass, cut into two pieces
- olive oil
- Chopped fresh herbs any combo will do, but I like dill, mint & parsley. Use whatever's in season!
- 1-2 lemons, zest half of one and reserve the zest
- 6 Tbsp olive oil
- sea salt & pepper, to taste
- splash of white wine (plus more for the chef)


Method:

- 1. Preheat the oven to 375
- 2. Put your beautiful fish in a baking pan with a drizzle of olive oil and a pinch of sea salt.
- 3. Put it on the middle oven rack and bake it for about 15-25 minutes, depending on the size and type of your fillets. Check after 15 minutes for doneness.
- 4. While the fish is cooking, make the lemon herb sauce: toss your herbs, olive oil, lemon zest and salt in a food processor and give it a whiz. Add olive oil and white wine until it becomes a thick but spreadable paste.
- 5. When your fish is cooked, plate it and spoon your sauce over the fish. The extra sauce goes great with roasted or boiled potatoes and greens of your choice. Add lemon wedges, and kiss the chef!

RECIPE OF THE MONTH by Mikee Rijavec (rest in peace)

- Mikey or "Key" A San Diego-based fisherman and content creator behind the SD Fish and Sips YouTube channel. Known for his positivity, adventurous spirit, and deep connection to the fishing community. Widely loved by anglers across Southern California and Baja for his generosity, humor, and passion for the ocean.
- Sad news that on Nov. 11, 2025, Mikey issued a mayday callwhile fishing solo about eight miles off Baja California, reporting engine trouble. His call abruptly cut off, and a massive search began involving the U.S. Coast Guard, Mexican Navy, local fishermen, private pilots, and volunteers. After five days of searching, Mikey's body was recovered near San Cristobalon Nov. 16, 2025. Tributes poured in across social media, fishing forums, and news outlets, reflecting the profound loss felt across the fishing world.
- He will continue to enrich other's lives through his YouTube channel. And this month we are proud to share his recipe for "Christmas Cioppino". Rest in peace Mikey.
