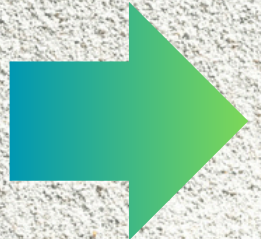

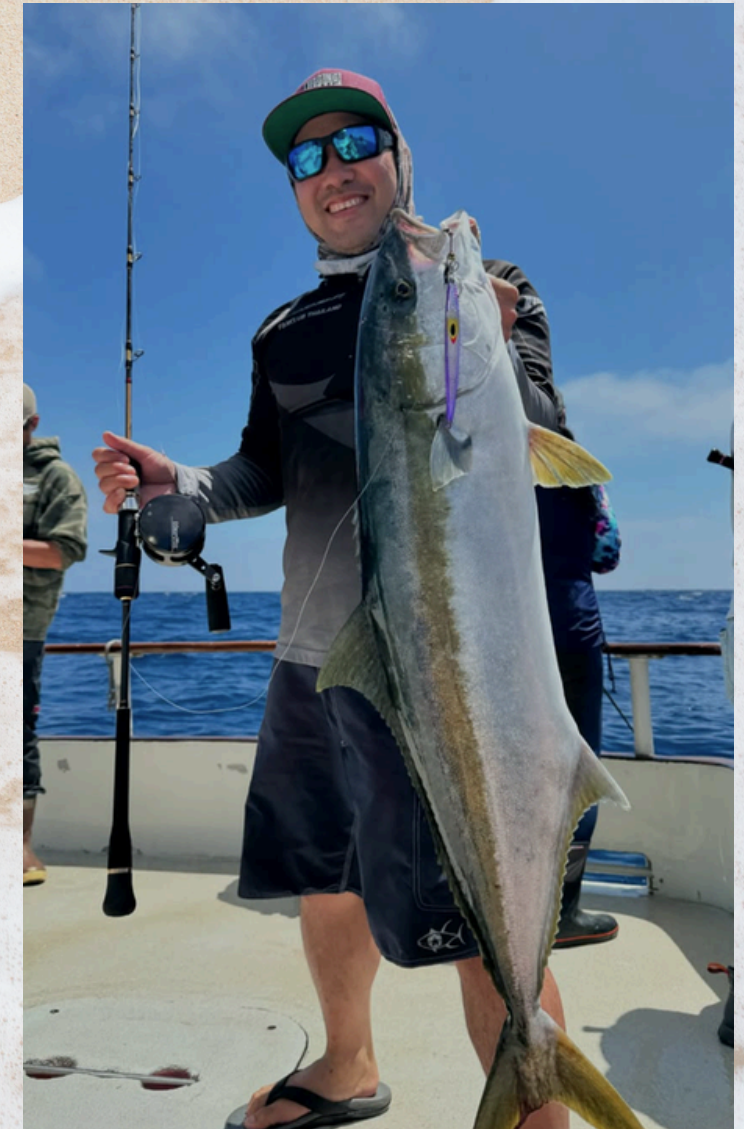
MORE ABOUT - OUR SPEAKER

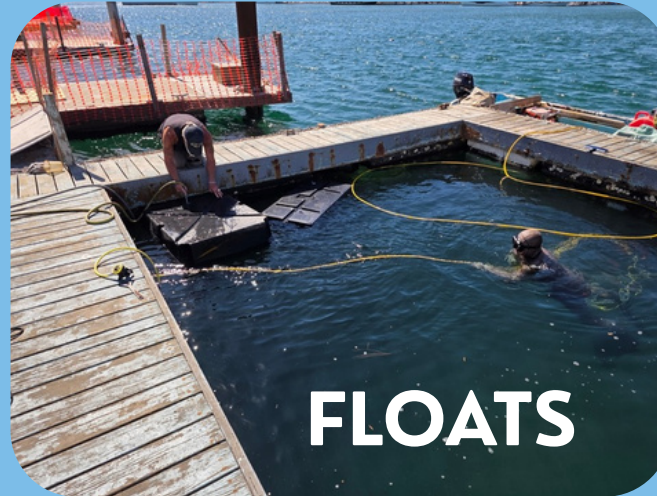
LATEST REPORT ~ APRIL 2026

WHITE SEABASS REPORT #2

REPORT SUBMITTED BY: Robert Groeber
CCA, Channel Islands Chapter, Secretary | April 2026

The pen closest to the break wall has been covered with marine grade plywood to create a larger workspace and to move the fish away from the runoff. We will open the middle pen and continue to use the furthest pen for the fish when they arrive in April.

Materials have been delivered to add new posts and crossbeams to enclose the pens to keep unwanted wildlife out.

Once the framework is up we will put up new fencing to complete the reconstruction, lots of work to do before the fish arrive sometime in April.

We do not yet have a date certain for delivery but will need to get lots of work done in the coming weeks!



The Alaskan Fish and Game Commission has added a new sport halibut daily fee. It is \$20 for each day halibut are targeted. Since the normal fishing practice at most lodges is to troll for salmon in early morning then switch to halibut and ling cod later in the day, this will be an effective \$20 per day license fee.

The new \$20 daily sport halibut fee takes effect in January 2026 for charter anglers in Alaska's IPHC Areas 2C and 3A. It's part of NOAA Fisheries' final rule for the Halibut Recreational Quota Entity (RQE) Program, and it applies each day halibut are targeted on guided trips.

Yes, the new \$20 daily sport halibut fee is real and takes effect in January 2026 for charter anglers in Alaska's IPHC Areas 2C and 3A. It's part of NOAA Fisheries' final rule for the Halibut Recreational Quota Entity (RQE) Program, and it applies each day halibut are targeted on guided trips.

Key Details About the New Halibut Fee

- **Effective Date:** January 2026
- **Fee Amount:** \$20 per day for each day halibut are targeted
- **Who Pays:** Anglers on charter (guided sport) vessels in IPHC Areas 2C (Southeast Alaska) and 3A (Southcentral Alaska)

How It Works:

- **Charter Halibut Permit (CHP)** holders must purchase electronic halibut stamps via NOAA's eFISH platform
- **Guides** validate stamps daily using Alaska Fish & Game's electronic logbooks (eLogbook)

Purpose:

- **Funds** go to the Recreational Quota Entity (RQE) to help purchase halibut quota shares from the commercial sector, potentially easing future charter restrictions

Practical Impact for Lodges and Anglers

- **Most lodge itineraries** include salmon trolling in the morning and halibut/lingcod fishing later, so this fee effectively applies every fishing day.
- **Anglers** should budget for \$20/day surcharge on top of standard license fees.
- **Lodges** may need to update trip descriptions and pricing to reflect this change.

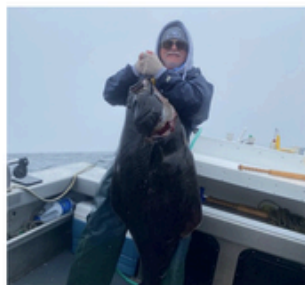

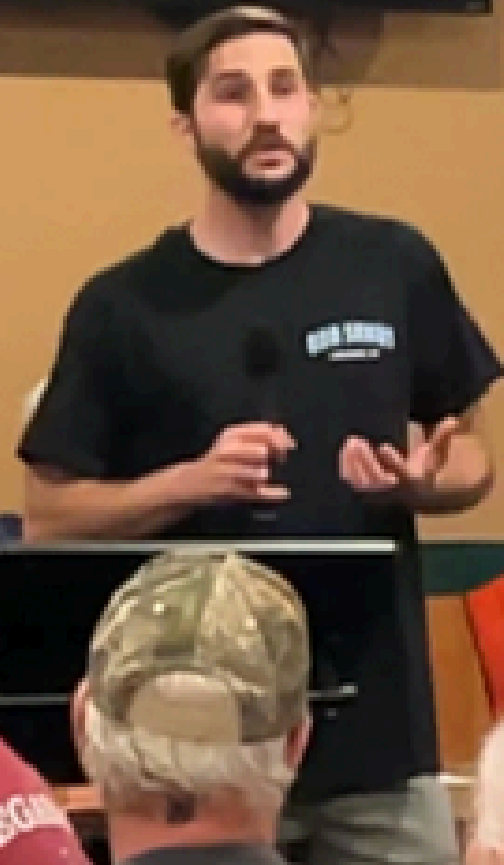

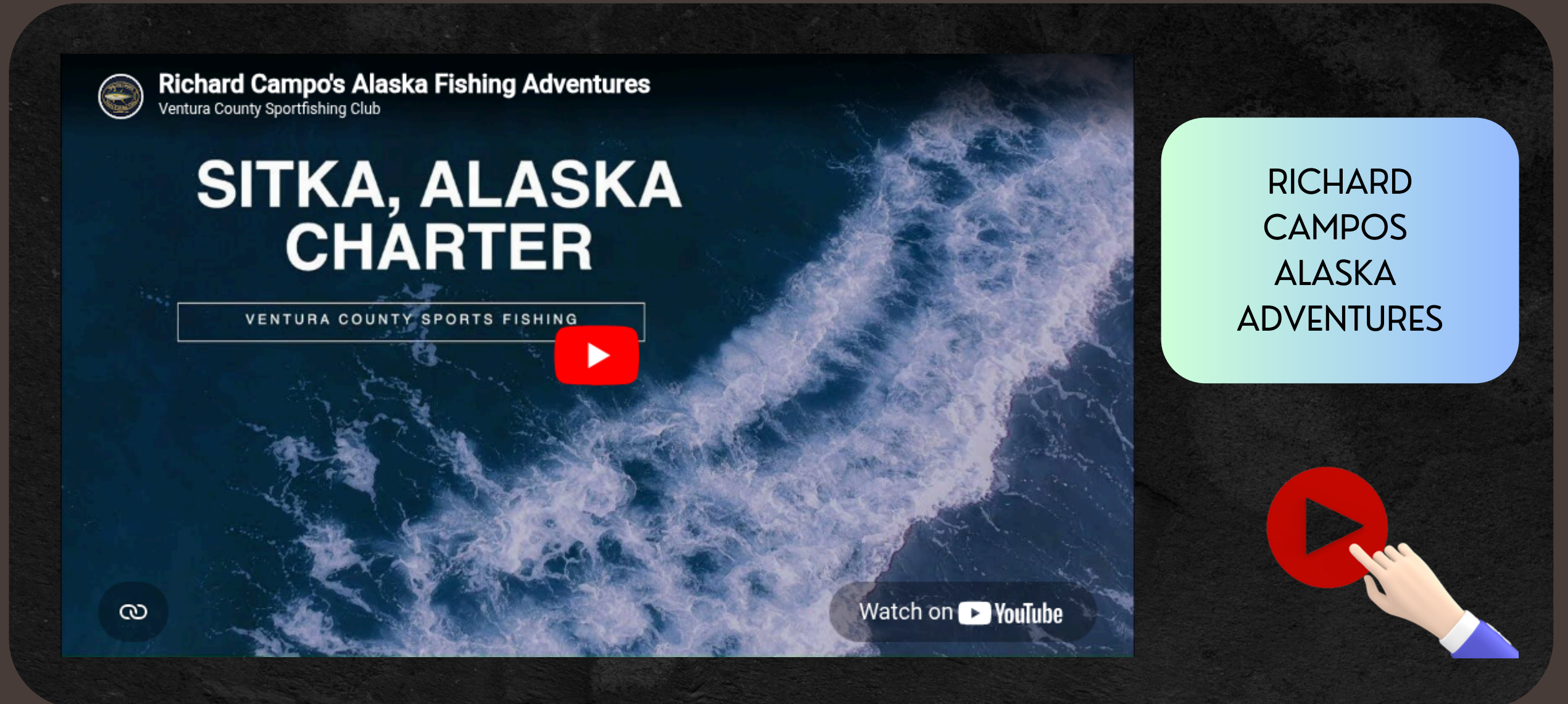

THE SPORTFISHING DISEASE IS REAL, AND IT JUST DOESN'T GO AWAY ... UNLESS YOU TRULY WANT IT TO.

But if I'm honest, repetitiveness can make even a well-oiled machine... well... repetitive.

I recall going to a Tony Robbins seminar for extra credit in High School. A point he was driving home the entire program was to continually challenge ourselves. As with anything in life, you have to work (hard) to keep things fresh, to keep things interesting, and to keep yourself interested.

Anchored up at Catalina, you can drop an anchovy over the side and catch a calico bass. But if you can cast it close to kelp or structure, you'll have a better shot at a legal size fish. Once you become proficient at casting, it's a blast fishing them with plastics.

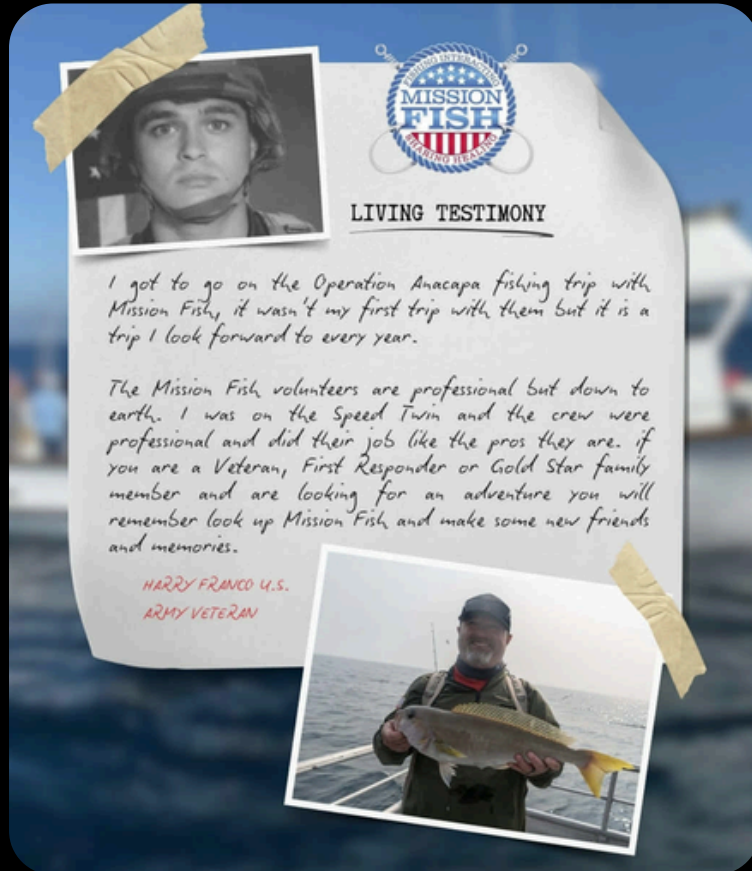
If you can cast far and accurate, calicos on the iron is a blast. Then you can try topwater. Each of these techniques requires their own set of thought processes. This is what I do and as long as I'm not a liability to myself or others, I don't offend anyone.

Every trip I want to cast a little further, more accurately, and more efficiently than the last. To catch a fish on something different. Dive into a new technique. Stay further ahead of problems or learn to get out of tangles faster.

Try a different color pattern or lure. Hook a bait differently. Work a lure differently. See how lures or bait behaves, and if the fish react to it.

Everytime I think I've figured it out, it turns out I don't. By constantly raising my personal standards, I keep myself in the pursuit. It's more challenging, more interesting, and makes it more fun. For me.

APRIL Recipe: Snapper on the Half Shell

Rush Maltz shares his favorite "Snapper on the Half Shell" recipe using mutton snapper fillets in this Mercury - Cook Your Catch feature.

Ingredients:

- 2 mutton snapper fillets (skin on)
- Olive oil
- Old Bay® Seasoning
- Garlic powder
- Black pepper
- Seasoning salt
- 1 white onion, sliced
- 1 lemon, sliced

Instructions:

1. Get started by preheating your grill to 375 degrees. Then, remove the pin bones from your snapper fillets, unless they've already been removed.

Interesting fact: Pin bones aren't actually bones at all, but calcified ligaments found in fish like salmon and snapper. Pin bones go from the edge of the fillet toward the center. The best way to remove them is to cut along each side of the row of bones and underneath and then simply pull them out with your hands.

2. The next step is to pat the fillets dry with paper towels. Then, evenly coat the fillets with olive oil. Sprinkle the top with a little bit of Old Bay Seasoning, garlic powder, black pepper and seasoning salt. Use a brush to distribute the seasonings evenly across the top of your fillets.
3. Next, lay your fillets, skin side down, onto the grill with the thickest part of the fillet in the center of the grill, and put the lid back on. At 375 degrees, it should take somewhere between 10 and 15 minutes to cook.

4. While your fish is cooking on the grill, sauté your onions in a pan with a little olive oil over medium-high heat. If you like your onions on the crunchier side like Capt. Maltz, this won't take more than a couple of minutes.
5. With your onions prepared, now is a good time to check on your snapper. You'll know your fish is ready when you can easily push a spatula through the fish in the thickest part of the fillet. Once they're done, remove the fillets from the grill and top with the sautéed onions and a squeeze of lemon.
6. It's a simple but absolutely delicious dish that can be served alongside rice and a salad for a well-balanced, healthy meal.
